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### **Summary Annual Report for ANNUITY FUND OF LOCAL NO. ONE, I.A.T.S.E.**

This is a summary of the annual report for the ANNUITY FUND OF LOCAL NO. ONE, I.A.T.S.E. (Employer Identification No. 13-3022965, Plan No. 001), for period January 1, 2019 through December 31, 2019. The annual report has been filed with the Employee Benefits Security Administration, U.S. Department of Labor, as required under the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA).

#### **Basic Financial Statement**

Benefits under the plan are provided through a trust fund. Plan expenses were \$37,201,160. These expenses included \$825,152 in administrative expenses, and \$36,376,008 in benefits paid to participants and beneficiaries. A total of 9,059 persons were participants in or beneficiaries of the plan at the end of the plan year, although not all of these persons had yet earned the right to receive benefits.

The value of plan assets, after subtracting liabilities of the plan, was \$1,067,036,883 as of December 31, 2019, compared to \$897,503,263 as of January 1, 2019. During the plan year the plan experienced an increase in its net assets of \$169,533,620. This increase includes unrealized appreciation and depreciation in the value of plan assets; that is, the difference between the value of the plan's assets at the end of the year and the value of the assets at the beginning of the year, or the cost of assets acquired during the year. The plan had total income of \$206,734,780, including employer contributions of \$43,555,747, employee contributions of \$1,913,791, gains from investments of \$159,578,271, and other income of \$1,686,971.

The plan has a contract with Massachusetts Mutual Life Insurance Company which allocates funds toward individual policies.

#### **Minimum Funding Standards**

Enough money was contributed to the plan to keep it funded in accordance with the minimum funding standards of ERISA.

#### **Your Rights to Additional Information**

You have the right to receive a copy of the full annual report, or any part thereof, on request. The items included in that report are (1) an accountant's report; (2) assets held for investment; (3) insurance information including sales commissions paid by insurance carriers; and (4) information regarding any common or collective trust, pooled separate accounts, master trusts or 103-12 investment entities in which the plan participates.

You also have the legally protected right to examine the annual report at the main office of the plan located at 320 West 46th Street, 6th floor, New York, NY, and at the U.S. Department of Labor in Washington, D.C., or to obtain a copy from the U.S. Department of Labor upon payment of copying costs.
